

PRIVACY POLICY

We may collect information from you through your use of our website, when you request information from us or engage our services. We may also collect telemetry data needed for the safety of our customers and our vehicles.

By using any of our services including our website and by providing us with any personal information, we understand that you are affirmatively and clearly consenting to the use of your personal information as set out in this policy. Information collected through our website

The purpose of these facilities is apparent at the point that you provide your personal information and we only use your information for those purposes.

What we use your personal information for

- To provide and improve this website, but always with your explicit consent.

- To market our services.
- To manage our relationship with you.
- To fulfil our contractual obligations to you.
- For the purposes of recruitment.
- For other legitimate business purposes.

Protection of your information

We apply the highest standard of security when it comes to hosting and protecting information.

We do not sell, rent, distribute or otherwise make personal information commercially available to any third party, except as described in this policy or with your prior permission.

Sharing information across our business network

Any information that you provide to us may be shared with and processed by any partners of ours under the strict rules of the GDPR.

Electronic communications

Legal Requirements

COOKIES

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

We currently do not use any cookies in our web site. We may however, in the future use Google Analytics cookies. These cookies help us improve our site by providing us with information about how users interact with our site. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All the information that the cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. You may change your browser settings to delete and block cookies.
